WWOOF originally stood for “Working Weekends On Organic Farms” and began in England in 1971. Sue Coppard, a woman working as a secretary in London, wanted to provide urban dwellers with access to the countryside, while supporting the organic movement. People soon started volunteering for longer periods than just weekends.
